PERSONAL PRONOUNS

I = Je or J' (Use "J' " when the verb starts with a vowel)

You (informal) = Tu

He = Il

She = Elle

We = Nous

You (formal) = Vous

They (masculine) = Ils

They (feminine) = Elles

Note : You use avoir (have) when you talk about age !!! You own your age (same thing in Spanish)

Note 2: Use avoir to talk about thirst and hunger. You own your thirst and hunger as well as you own your age!!!

J'ai faim (I am hungry... or literally, I have hunger) vs. J'ai soif (I am thirsty... or rather, I have thirst)

CONJUGATION OF REGULAR VERBS - ER VERBS

1. Drop the -ER ending
2. Add to the stem the ending matching the personal pronouns

Je - E

Tu -ES

Il / Elle -E

Nous -ONS

Vous -EZ

Ils / Elles - ENT

Understanding the conjugation of ER verbs

Ex : DESIRER (desire)

Je désire (I desire)

Tu désires (you desire)

Il désire (he desires)

Elle désire (she desires)

Nous désirons (we desire)

Vous désirez (you desire, formal)

Ils désirent (they desire, masc.)

Elles désirent (they desire, fem.)
