

du / de la / de l' / des = "some" or "of the" or "from the"

"du" + masc / sing noun:

- 1) Je voudrais **du pain**. = I would like **some bread**.
- 2) Il voudrait **du sel**. = He would like **some salt**.
- 3) Vous voulez **du thé**? = Do you want **some tea**?
- 4) Ils voudraient **du café**. = They would like **some coffee**.
- 5) Je viens **du Maroc**. = I come **from (the) Morocco**.
- 6) Tu viens **du cinéma**? = Are you coming **from the movie theater**?
- 7) Il fait **du golf**. = He plays (**some**) **golf**.
- 8) On fait **du piano**. = We play **the piano**.
- 9) C'est le fils **du maire**. = He is the **mayor's** son. (This is the son **of the mayor**)
- 10) C'est la fille **du voisin**. = She is the **neighbor's** daughter.

"de la" + fem / sing noun:

- 11) Je voudrais **de la mayonnaise**. = I would like **some mayonnaise**.
- 12) Tu veux **de la salade**? = Do you want **some salad**?
- 13) Il veut **de la dinde**? = Does he want **some turkey**?
- 14) On fait **de la place**. = We are making (**some**) **room**.
- 15) Vous faites **de la monnaie**? = Are you making (**some**) **change**?
- 16) Ils font **de la planche à voile**. = They do (**some**) **windsurfing**.
- 17) Je fais **de la guitare**. = I play **the guitar**.
- 18) Tu as **de la chance**. = You are lucky. (You have **some luck**)
- 19) C'est le **gouverneur de la** Californie. = He is the **governor of** California.
- 20) Il vient **de la plage**. = He's coming **from the beach**.

“de l’” + singular noun followed by a vowel or “h”:

- 21) Il a **de l’ambition**. = He has (**some**) **ambition**.
- 22) Vous voulez **de l’eau**? = Do you want (**some**) **water**?
- 23) Ils ont **de l’argent**. = They have (**some**) **money**.
- 24) J’ai **de l’imagination**. = I have (**some**) **imagination**.
- 25) Tu prends **de l’eau**? = Are you having (**some**) **water**?
- 26) Il voudrait **de l’ail**. = He would like (**some**) **garlic**.
- 27) On vient **de l’église**. = We’re coming **from the church**.
- 28) Ils viennent **de l’aéroport**. = They’re coming **from the airport**.
- 29) C’est le livre **de l’élève**. = This is the student’s book (...book **of the student**)
- 30) C’est un prof **de l’école**. = He is a teacher **from the school**.

“des” + any plural noun:

- 31) J’ai **des amis** français. = I have (**some**) French **friends**.
- 32) Tu as **des problèmes**. = You have (**some**) **issues**.
- 33) Il mange **des frites**. = He is eating (**some**) **French fries**.
- 34) Elle a **des CDs** de Madonna. = She’s got (**some**) **CD’s** of Madonna.
- 35) C’est le **drapeau des** Américains. = It is the **flag of the** Americans.
- 36) On a **des billets** de vingt euros. = We have (**some**) 20 euro **bills**.
- 37) Ce sont les enfants **des voisins**. = These are the children **of the neighbors**.
- 38) Ce sont **des voleurs**. = They are (**some**) **thieves**.
- 39) Ils viennent **des Etats-Unis**. = They come **from the US**.
- 40) Vous prenez **des fraises**? = Are you having (**some**) **strawberries** ?
